Restore Reproductive Health

On November 7th, Diane Cosgrove will speak to the youth about a new local ministry called Restore Reproductive Health. According to their Facebook page, this crisis pregnancy center provides compassionate, actionable assistance to people who have suffered sexual-related trauma (SRT). Some of their services include parenting classes referral to community resources such as job skills training, birthing options and breastfeeding instruction; adoption agencies transportation; maternity closet; baby clothes and equipment and much more! Then **on November 21st**, the youth will be taught by Amanda Rothe how to make fleece baby blankets that they can then be donated to Restore Reproductive Health.
